Laramie Soccer Club Scholarship Guidelines

Programs:

Competitive- teams travel to play outside Laramie and have some home games

- U8-U10 may register for one season (fall or spring), or the full soccer year (fall and spring)
- U11-U14 registration is for the full soccer year, if rosters allow, players may be allowed to register for spring only
- U15-U19 girls register for fall only

Intramural- all practices and games held in Laramie

• Pre-K-6th grade have opportunities to play in the fall, winter and spring, not all ages offered every season

Off-Season- in town programming, available to all skill levels

• Various camps, 3v3 leagues and other training opportunities offered throughout the year

Request Deadlines:

Competitive-

- Fall and full year registrations, requests due by May 15
- Spring registration, requests due by January 15

Intramural-

• Requests due 2 weeks before program begin date

Off-Season-

• Requests due 2 weeks before program begin date

Family portion of fees:

Competitive-

- Parent pays Wyoming Soccer Association insurance and dues, approximately \$39. One-time payment for the soccer year (Aug. 1-July 31)
- Parent pays a minimum of 20% of the registration fee.

Intramural-

- Parent pays Wyoming Soccer Association insurance and dues, approximately \$23. One-time payment for the soccer year (Aug. 1-July 31)
- Parent chooses how much they can pay, recommend a minimum of \$20 for registrations that do not include the WSA fee.

Off-Season-

- Parent pays Wyoming Soccer Association insurance and dues, approximately \$23. One-time payment for the soccer year (Aug. 1-July 31)
- Parent pays 50% of the registration fee.

Qualification:

All Programs-

- Families who qualify for the school district free and reduced lunch program will qualify for a scholarship. Parent/Guardian will be asked to upload a copy of their qualifying letter.
- Other circumstances may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
